Flood relief:







Though we were in rainy season, unexpected continues heavy rain in late Nov and two weeks in Dec affected many people and destroyed the cultivations. There were floods in all roads and around the houses preventing their movements. A few got water in to their houses or kitchen. As a result of these situations they were compelled to go to the State Relief centres or relations houses. NTI Project Officers and Volunteers visited the community to advise on reporting to the State authorities and to assess damages. Their assessment of damages on the villages of Killnochchi,Palai, Puthumadam, Navaly, Moolai, Tholpuram and Pandavedai were reported to the Chairperson. In response to our appeal contributions were received from the following: Messer's Ravi Canagsabey-Canada Rs;500,000. Shan USA 100US \$, ISLF- USA 500 US\$ Two more remittances of Rs;19,000 and 73,000 were received without notification. Financial assistance was released to selected 30 persons in these 8 villages. A list of more beneficiaries is being prepared. This is to make sure that deserving candidates are given preference'

Since then on 12th 13th and 14th Dec there was continues rain that disturbed lives of many. NTI will concentrate more in Killinochchi area and establish a resources team to conduct the monthly leadership training seminar. Further support will be in the form of chicks, seeds and seedlings.

Project Officers (POs) decided to visit Kayalini PO and along with her all beneficiaries to accelerate the progress. They visited 18 beneficiaries and found the poultry project was moving smoothly. Kadupulam beneficiaries pledged to cooperate in making the project a very success.








Leadership Training Batch III

Prabhath earlier gifted 100 layers for 30 families. He had many plans such as marketing eggs, and form a poultry farmers co-operative. NTI is earnestly working towards reaching the target.
