3. Review meetings by the NTI Branches

Ten branches that of Ponnagar, Eththavil Palai, Thirunagar South and North in Killinochchi area, Navaly, Kadupulam, Pandavedai, Tholpuram, Molai and Putumadam held their meetings. Details of a few review meetings are given below:

i) Ponnagar South – Killinochchi.

Ponnagar South Beneficiaries meeting held on 26th Jan attended by 18 beneficiaries on the direction of Deveika PO. A laudable act is that Dvika persuaded 14 beneficiaries agreeing to gift chicks to 6 new beneficiaries. Ponnagar branch has set up an example and the NTI board appreciates this gesture and congratulates Devika the PO.



jj) Eiththavil, Palai Branch

At the meeting Menaka PO reminded the targets and conditions. It is clear to them that further assistace will be considered only if they achieved the targets. Beneficiaries shared success and difficutlies.



lii Navaly Branch

Beneficiaries meeting was conducted by Thusikanthi PO on 26th Jan. There were 21 persons in attendance. Thousand rupees worth Seedlings of brinjol, tomato, chili, capsicum were supplied by Thusikanthi PO. Another person donated seeds of long beans and Indian murunga. Lively sharing of their experiences also took place.



Iv) Kadupulam Branch.

Ten beneficiaries of Kadupulam branch attended the meeting held on 31st Jan at the community centre. Second meeting was held on 2nd Feb at which another ten members attended. Baby who increased her business to 15 birds was happy to pose for a photograph with the director. There were three beneficiaries who raised up to ten birds. They shared their experiences and agreed to meet again in March. Kayalini PO led the discussion.



v) **Puthumadam** Branch. Preya PO directed the meeting and provided Rs;1000 worth seedlings to 8 of them.



Vi) Pandavedai Branch;

Ten out of twenty beneficiaries attended the meeting. Other half will meet on another day . Vickneswarn a beneficiary Promised to provide chili seedlings and agreed to sell farm products at his shop. One of his friends sponsored the purchase of a land with shop which is managed by his daughter Abigha an old student of NTI.



Vii) Tholpuiram Branch.

Thirty-five women 100% beneficiaries and five other motivated women engaged in self employment activities attended the meeting with much zeal. Thirty beneficiaries out of 32 (97%) have reached the stage in the target of having 10 birds .





viii) Moolai Branch

Moolai Branch covers large area and has 3POs i.e. HGP 01, FRPK 02. A meeting was convened on 31.01 attended by ten beneficiaries. Nilojini PO a veteran poultry farmer, manages 25 birds and added 10 one day old chick bought at Rs.1,70 each in this week. Half of the beneficiaries have increased more than ten birds. At present two beneficiaries have put two birds 12 eggs each on traditional hatching.



(ix) Thirunagar North Branch.

All beneficiaries in Thirunagar North have reached the target of 10 birds each. kalaiselvi the PO is enthusiastically working despite her heart ailment. She is yet to get her phone repaired.
