There are 700 beneficiaries in Home Gardening Project, HGP and Free Range Poultry Keeping, FRPK. Fifteen females set up their entrepreneur businesses. Thirty students completed their skill training and employed. Our Business English and ICT classes are continuing. Corona virus and economic situation made NTI to pivot to Sustainable Upliftment and Rural Empowerment (SURE) program. 154 students have gone through the formal classes from 2017 to date. NTI conducts ICT short courses

These methods of reporting makes the POs effective and motivate the beneficiaries to continue the operation success.

A competition was introduced among the beneficiaries of HGP and FRPK. POs from near by NTI Branch visited and recommended the winners including Killinochi and each of them were given a gift of Rs;1000/

# Leadership seminar Batch II





There were thirty-five participants registered for the Batch II and two leadership Seminars have been conducted so far on Feb  $6^{th}$ , & March 2nd, Seminars will continue for this second batch. Registration was sealed and participants strictly adhere to submission requirements. In put was made by Gobi the Chair and he made the POs to share their experiences and success stories. Ms.S.Devika PO started the FRPK project. She visited the prospective beneficiaries and check the condition of the Poultry shed and sent necessary information to the NTI main Office.

Chicks (2 hens & 1 cockerel per family) worth of Rs;77,000 were issued to 10 beneficiaries. Chicks were purchased with the recommendation of the Govt livestock officer Killinochchi.
