About 25 NTI beneficiaries who are engaged in the self-employment business brought their products such as: curry & masala powder, 'Saththu ma', Mushroom, craft work, dresses, vegetables and plants.

NTI community members' 50 and passersby in the bazaar about 50 visited our exhibition. The cost of the exhibition should have been at least Rs; 150,000 but due to the hard work of every one it was only 40,000/

POs and volunteers, 19 of them assembled at the centre benefited a lot by participating at his instructions group study and role plays. Finally they were asked to look back the day they joined the NTI and the present development they made tus far. It was emotional and enthusiastic testimonies. Jana said she was very shy person and when NTI considered her for the position of Project Officer, she was reluctant to accept and the Project Representative discouraged it. Jana spoke confidently on her leadership abilities and thanked the NTI. The Project representative who was present there commended on her personal development.

Another person said when NTI began its activities at his village in 2019 there were no teachers or Govt servants. Due to NTI activities many have got good passes in English language, two entered college of ducation, Two got care giver training at the Institute of Medial Science, Manipy. Five cycles were given in support of their work and studies both free and subsidised cost with instalment settlement.

Group work, outcome was presented and decided that Pasanithy and Prasanthini present their reports at a proposed Zoom meeting. A formal vote of thank you was expressed by Ms.Gowthami. Nithuson a male dancer, Tholpuram Branch spontaneously performed a dance in appreciation of Doctor's services. Dr.Canagarjah also responded and made a contribution of !000 UDS \$ that fetched Rs;307,000/

ISLF Project provided supply of five reconditioned cycles to be given on 50% subsidised cost to NTI Working students. Accordingly the fifth bicycle was provided to P.Thanushiya, NTI PO Moolai & a preschool teacher, at a subsidise cost of Rs;10,000, monthly instalment of Rs;1000/



8. Visit to new village at Moolai Central Vaddukodai.

The NTI team visited Moolai Central with the support of Branch Representative Uvatharshini . We provided necessary instructions on carrying out the NTI activities. Young members submitted applications seeking support in their self-employment and career pursuits. We have started a poultry project there and selected ten families. Ably assisted by Jana PO Pandavedai each family was given (1 male and 2 female) 3 birds. A few families were supplied with seeds and seedling to start the Home Garden project as well.



9. Leadership Batch II

Sixth training session was held on 6th June with 17 participants including Palai and Killinchchi. As the program is nearing completion output from individuals are increasing. Every session has a new subject to motivate and participants volunteer to share their experiences. Gobinath provided leadership.
