### 1. Establishment of more NTI Branches at new villages is continuing:

NTI is expanding its services to deserving villages in Jaffna and Killinochchi districts. NTI team visited the following villages on 17<sup>th</sup> Aug. The team visited in order;

1. Kaladdi in Keerimalai,	No:37	
2. Nallenakka puram ( a Govt settlement village )	No:38	
3. Thyyiddi Thiruvalluvar village	No;39	
4. & Kaali kovil village.	No;40	

These four villages have dry red soil full of lime stones. As there is water scarcity cultivation is not ventured. Each village has an average of 400 families except one with 900 families. Their main income is from menial daily labour work; fish and vegetable vending at markets. The team organised them as a formal group with a leader to communicate with NTI and arranged two persons to attend the monthly leadership seminar. The group leaders are expected to hold discussion and submit their self employment plans . Ms.Sathyiyarubi a Pre-school coordinator in Arlali joined the NTI team and visited all the villages. Dinopan, Branch Representative, from Paandaveddai also joined us.




#### 3, Leadership Seminar Batch (III)
